What is RCIA?

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process established by the universal Church for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation- Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. This initiation process also involves a parish community experiencing a renewal of faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. The Rite speaks of conversion as a "spiritual journey." Centered on fostering a deep relationship with Jesus and the Church He founded, this journey takes place through distinct stages over a period of time suitable to bring about a thorough catechesis, significant experience of the parish community, and commitment to the liturgical and moral life of the Catholic faithful. The RCIA process is a restoration of the ancient catechumenate, arising within the first three centuries following the era of the apostles. The Second Vatican Council called for the restoration and use of this venerable and powerful method of initiation for the worldwide Church.

Who is RCIA for?

1. Persons in need of Baptism
2. Persons baptized in another Christian tradition who desire to become Catholic
3. Persons baptized Catholic in need of First Communion and/or Confirmation

Rachael's Vineyard retreats are beautiful and powerful in their healing ministry. We all have things in our past that we regret and can be trapped with the misconception that we couldn't be forgiven for that. That is not at all what scripture or the Catholic Church teaches. St. Mary of Egypt was an accomplished seductress but realized the enormity of her sins, went to confession and completely turned her life around. St. Olga massacred an entire tribe and sold people into slavery, she was overwhelmed by the Liturgy of the Church asked for forgiveness and became a humble missionary. St. Vladimir was involved with rape and murder and he on being converted completely changed his ways. Thomas Becket at one point was extremely wealthy and cold hearted had a conversion experience that resulted in him being a champion for the Church. Look at the Woman at the well, the woman caught in adultery and St. Paul in the scriptures.
